Meeting Minutes, June 8, 2017

The Police and Fire Commission met on Thursday, June 8, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in the first floor conference room at City Hall, 444 West Grand Avenue, Wisconsin Rapids.

1. Call the meeting to order.

Commissioner Jerabek called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

2. Roll call.

All commissioners were in attendance, as well as Fire Chief Dave Kerkman.

3. Consider appointment of Erman Blevins as Wisconsin Rapids Police Chief.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jerabek, seconded by Commissioner Nash to appoint Erman Blevins to Wisconsin Rapids Police Chief effective July 5, 2017. Motion carried.

4. Closed session.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jerabek, seconded by Commissioner Dewitt, to go into closed session, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Sec. 19.85 (1)(c), to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the Commission has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

In closed session, the Commission interviewed Entry-Level Firefighter candidates and established an Entry-Level Firefighter eligibility list.

5. Open session.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jerabek, seconded by Commissioner Dauenhauer to go into open session. Motion carried.

Re Item 4a: The Commission interviewed three (3) entry-level firefighter candidates.

Re Item 4b: The Commission placed five (5) candidates on the Entry-Level Firefighter eligibility list, as well as the two (2) candidates remaining on the previous list, as discussed at the May 17, 2017 meeting.
