**1. 1st Street N (Poplar St City Limits) Project**

American Asphalt completed the 1<sup>st</sup> lift (2-1/2") on 800' this week. Construction of the water main is complete and the new main is flushed, tested and fully operational. Only one short piece of sanitary sewer construction remains North of Strawberry Lane. This remaining utility work should be completed early next week.

**2. 8<sup>th</sup> Street & East Grand Avenue Project**

Work completed this week included paving the asphalt approaches, traffic signal installation, and striping.

**3. Washington St ( 8<sup>th</sup> St -12<sup>th</sup> ST) Project**

Reconstruction of Washington St, between 8<sup>th</sup> St N and 12<sup>th</sup> St N has been delayed several weeks and may not begin until early September.

**Looking Ahead for Next Week: 7/31/2017 – 8/04/2017**

1<sup>st</sup> St N will be closed next week between Strawberry Lane and the north City limits beginning Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 am for crews install the remaining underground utilities. This work is expected to take three days. Crews will then begin construction of a 320' retaining wall at the North end of the project.

**Impact to Residents:** Local Traffic will have access to Strawberry Lane via 1<sup>st</sup> St N from Pleasant View Drive to the south. Traffic heading north to Biron will be detoured on Spring Street to Hwy 54. Traffic heading south to Wisconsin Rapids will be detoured onto 32<sup>nd</sup> Street N to Hwy 54.

The 8th Street/East Grand Ave project is projected to open next week.
