

## **Resident Compost Tags**

Individuals who wish to use the East or West Side Compost Sites must have a Compost Tag to gain access. This year the Compost Tags have changed color to yellow. If you have a red tag, you will need to get a new one for this year. Compost passes are good as long as the individual remains a Wisconsin Rapids Resident or owns property within the City Limits, they do not have to be renewed annually.

Residents of the City of Wisconsin Rapids may use either the West or East side Compost Sites free of Charge. A Compost tag can be obtained from the East Side Compost site gate attendant on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday. The West Side Compost Site has a gate attendant available on Tuesday & Thursday from 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m. or Saturday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. When the attendant is available, residents may get a compost pass at this site. Resident compost passes are also available at the City Garage, 1411 Chase St., Wisconsin Rapids.
