



1. Call the meeting to order.

Commissioner King called the meeting to order at 7:33 a.m.

2. Roll call.

Present in person at City Hall were Commissioners Albrecht, Grode, King and Yonkovich; and Fire Chief Todd Eckes and Ryan Hartman.

3. The Commission may discuss and consider changes to Entry-Level Firefighter/Paramedic candidates' minimum qualifications.

The Commission confirmed that this opportunity would be an addition to the current minimum qualifications, not a replacement for the current minimum qualifications.

A motion was made by Commissioner Yonkovich, seconded by Commissioner Grode, that Entry-Level Firefighter/Paramedic candidates who have earned EMT-Paramedic state license are not required to earn the Firefighter I certification before hire, but will be required to earn the Firefighter I certification after being hired. These candidates will be offered the class in-house and be paid at the entry level rate. Motion carried.
