The City of Wisconsin Rapids is searching for a temporary Civil Engineering Technician. This individual will perform a variety of entry-level duties as a member of a survey crew or civil engineering design section. This is a temporary, non-benefits eligible position for the summer months.

Primary responsibilities of this position include the following:

- Locates City's utilities as required by Digger's Hotline.
- Performs storm sewer outfall testing.
- Assists in gathering information and data by field and office research.
- Clears survey lines, places monuments or stakes, measures distances, records field notes, and other work as directed by survey crew chief.
- Performs routine office assignments in elementary drafting and design. Posts records and notes and prepares forms. Performs mathematical computations. Reads and interprets engineering drawings.
- Performs required maintenance for surveying instruments, equipment, tools, vehicles, and supplies. Assists in checking the adjustment of surveying instruments, equipment, and tools.
- Assists staff in inspection of construction projects, sample taking and testing, traffic counts, etc.
- Performs CAD drafting; inputs GIS data.
- Operates standard office/drafting equipment.
- Performs other related tasks as directed by the immediate supervisor.

Candidates must be a graduate of or currently enrolled in a two-year or four-year Civil Engineering program.
