Airport Development:

Obstruction Removal update: SEH and WIBOA are working on scheduling a kickoff meeting and seeking consensus on dates.

Master Plan update: The WIBOA is working on administrative loose ends before the project can begin. The Commission may be asked to commit funding for upfront costs which may expedite the kickoff of this project. Those costs will be reimbursed when the federal and state funding is secured.

Other Airport Items:

ARPA/CRSAA submission: The CRSAA grant for \$13,000 has been received. According to the WIBOA, the ARPA grant of \$32,000 was paid as well. COWR Finance Dept. has been asked to confirm receipt of this grant.

Hangar security system: The system is up and running and some post-install glitches are being worked out.

Summer help pay rate: The proposed pay increase for Tom Becker failed to attain HR Committee approval but ultimately passed at the City Council meeting and will be effective next pay period.

Fuel Truck: There is an ongoing pneumatic system problem with and the COWR streets department is trying to identify a solution. The truck is operable but not optimal. As of now there are no expenses to report.

Jet Fuel cabinet: The truck loading system is not working properly. There is a manual workaround, but this issue will need attention. Information will be forthcoming as received.

Base Radio: The UNICOM frequency base radio is out of service. A vendor specializing in radio and antenna service is being sought. Information will be forthcoming as received.
