



## EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

### Aquatics & Building Maintenance Technician

The City of Wisconsin Rapids has an employment opportunity for an Aquatics & Building Maintenance Technician position within the Department of Public Works. The purpose of this position is to perform aquatic facilities and park maintenance, assist with the maintenance of the building and grounds for all City-owned properties, to include various mechanical and electrical equipment and plumbing.

Primary responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Inspects and maintains the cleanliness of the pool and aquatic center and other aquatic features.
- Maintains quality of the pool water by testing and maintaining the chemical levels.
- Inspects, maintains, and repairs equipment such as: pumps, suction lines, drains, pipes, tanks, valves, and flow and control switches.
- Assists with preventative maintenance and keeps records on all mechanical, electrical, and pneumatic equipment. Also maintains records on all pool maintenance activities.
- Coordinates purchase of spare parts for all types of equipment or systems, lighting, replacements, tools, janitor supplies, etc.
- Assists with snow and ice removal for City Hall and/or other City properties – can include snow blowing, ice scraping, and sanding and salting.
- Assists with daily occurrences at City Hall to include unlocking of doors and turns on lights, emergency needs for fire alarm, security and HVAC systems during non-work hours.
- Assists with basic lawn maintenance and removal of leaves.
- Follows all proper safety protocols.
- Respond to emergencies during non-work hours and weekends (rotational schedule).
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements for this position include a high school diploma or GED with training at a technical/vocational school with a focus on plumbing and park/recreation, mechanics or related field. Three years of pool maintenance, plumbing, park and recreation or related experience. Experience in plumbing, park and recreation, mechanics or related field. Knowledge of reading blueprints and maintenance manuals. Experience in building management and control software such as Insight by Siemens is preferred. Must be able to work in outdoor and indoor environmental conditions from extreme heat, rain, snow, humidity to extreme cold. Lift 50-100 lbs. on occasion and 20-50 lbs. continuously five days per week.

Possess or ability to obtain and retain a Certified Pool Operators License. A valid CDL class B with air breaks or ability to obtain one within 6 months of employment is required. If a CDL is already obtained, registration with FMCSA is required.

The pay rate is \$28.00/hour.
