



Policies:

- 1) No hunting is permitted within 100 yards of any structure, building, residence, recreation trail or park.
- 2) No driving of deer will be permitted.
- 3) No blinds or tree stands may be left overnight on city property.
- 4) Written permission must be obtained from the landowner for hunting prior to pursuing or retrieving a wounded or dead animal from private property. [Municipal Code Section 25.09 (1)(b) and Wisconsin Statutes 943.13].

Conditions:

It is the responsibility of the hunter to first establish ownership of the land they wish to hunt and then obtain written permission from said landowner to hunt on their property whether it be private or public land and to follow the above city policy.
