Refuse and Recycling

- Garbage Collection estimate 445.52 tons, 472.57 tons in 2023
- Recycling Collection estimate 98.7 tons 104.79 tons in 2023

Construction

Apricot/ Broadway Street Intersection

- Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter completed
- Curb was backfilled and topsoil placed
- Gravel was finished graded and American Asphalt paved on 5/30
- Field Stone wall restored
- Project is completed

Lincoln Street (Peach Street – East Riverview Expressway)

- Removed asphalt, curb and gutter, sidewalk and black dirt from 1000' of roadway
- Installed 897' of 8" sanitary main, 7 Services and 4 manholes
- Installed over 600' of 12" ductile water main 7 Services, 2 fire hydrants and valves
- Installed 3 Storm Manholes, 4 Catch Basins and associated piping
- Sub graded existing sand and hauled in road base for 400' of roadway
- Finish graded and adjusted manholes to prepare for paving for 750' of roadway

Streets Maintenance

- Mastic crack repair 8th Street from East Riverview Expressway – East Grand Ave
- Remove excess dirt, installed fresh black dirt, seed and mulch areas that were disturbed in sidewalk repair areas and Curb and Gutter replacement area completed by Sommers
- Poured Curb and gutter, sidewalk and approach slab in alley maintenance areas. Restored black dirt seeded and mulched
- Saw cut asphalt patches in curb repair areas
- Saw cut asphalt patches in sanitary repair areas
- Catch basin maintenance in curb and gutter maintenance areas
- Completed second brush pickup for the year. Providing an additional brush collection week of June 3 due to the amount of additional collection requested from the wind and hail storms in May
- Cold Patch City Streets
- Completed street patches from water main breaks and sanitary repairs
- Began string trimming around signs and light poles
- Began patching asphalt in curb and gutter repair areas
- Cleaned out catch basins from storm debris
- Swept bike trails from wind debris

- Began sweeping entire streets to clean up from storms where needed
- Replaced rings and castings on multiple Catch Basins in curb repair area
- Completed complete rebuild on two Catch Basins
- Started mowing road R/W on days that it wasn't raining
- Removed asphalt, added gravel and paved asphalt patches on the bike trail from Gaynor Ave to Seneca Road
- Graded gravel roads throughout the city
- Completed the spring yard waste collection

Paint and Signs

- Continue replacement of the Stop, Yield and regulatory signs that no longer meet the requirements of the MUTCD
- Removed existing signs in Lincoln Street Construction areas
- Started painting crosswalks and parking stalls throughout the city
- Made directional signs through the construction zone of Lincoln street to get spectators to Witter Field parking area
- Installed Memorial walk banners on Grand Ave
- Installed Flags and Banners for Memorial day
- Took delivery of traffic paint for summer painting

Shop and Repairs

- Routine service work fleet trucks
- Service Police and Fire's fleet
- Replaced hydraulic cylinders on a garbage truck
- Put two new Multi Axle trucks into service
- Replaced pins on loader arms and quick coupler of Volvo Loader
- Replace pins on quick coupler on buckets of second Volvo Loader
- Change mower blades on lawnmower weekly
- Serviced Vector Truck and replaced tires
- Switched snow tires to construction tires for pit loader
