- 3. Bicycle Benefits/Bike Share Program Sarah Salewski
 - a. A program that offers discounts/coupons for anyone riding bike that stops in to the store. Stickers to wear on your helmet will be available for purchase to get the discount.
 - b. Starter kits are available for any businesses that are willing to participate. Kits include some information on the program and stickers, one big sticker for the store window and small stickers for purchase to be placed on the bike helmet.
