

Hold Whitrock Rites Monday

Funeral services will be held at 2:15 p.m. Monday at St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church for Fred J. Whitrock, 66, 130 18th Ave. S., who died at noon Friday at Riverview Hospital of a head injury received in a fall on Wednesday.

The Rev. William Lange is to officiate and burial will take place in Forest Hill Cemetery.

Mr. Whitrock was born in the town of Seneca on April 18, 1891, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Matt J. Whitrock and was a lifelong resident of the community. He married Eleanora Engel in this city on Sept. 24, 1914.

Surviving are his wife; two daughters, Geraldine Whitrock and Mrs. John H. Rotermund; three brothers, Mark C., Walter F. and Ervin A. Whitrock, and one granddaughter, all of Wisconsin Rapids. His parents and one sister preceded him in death.

Mr. Whitrock, who served as mayor of Wisconsin Rapids for one term, 1932-34, was alderman for the 6th and 7th Wards for a number of years and since 1940 had been employed as an operator at the city sewage treatment plant.
