Parks & Recreation Commission Minutes

March 9, 2020

The Parks & Recreation Commission met on Monday, March 9, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., in the first floor conference room at City Hall, 444 West Grand Avenue, Wisconsin Rapids, WI.

Commission members in attendance: Kelly Rosecrans, Craig Broeren, Tom Ekelin, Carolynn Martin, and Lee Thao. Staff attending were Matt Heideman, Joe Terry, and Mary Wolosek. Also in attendance were Dennis Polach and Elizabeth Whelan.

1. Call to Order.

Commissioner Rosekrans called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

2. Approve February 10, 2020 meeting minutes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Broeren, seconded by Commissioner Thao, to approve the February 10, 2020, meeting minutes. Motion carried.

3. Consider request for benches to be placed on the bike path that runs from the Zoo to Port Edwards.

Replacement and additional benches will be placed in this area through the Parks & Recreation Celebration Bench program.

4. Update on Bear Pen construction at the Zoo.

As part of the master plan, the bear pen will be re-designed. The bear pen will be covered by a new roof top, black mesh fencing, and clearances, following state guidelines.

5. Update on Witter Field improvements (Rafter's).

Restrooms at Witter Field are being updated, completed by spring. Commissioner Ekelin requests a referral for clarification of the Park & Recreation Commission's role regarding the financial process.

6. Update on fence at Witter Field.

Bids accepted for outfield safety net. The net will be elevated at the beginning of the season, and lowered at the end of the season.

7. Update on Aquatic Recreational Center.

The Commission will be taking a tour of the facility on Friday, March 13, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. Surrounding municipalities were sent an invitation to participate in the Aquatic Recreational Center as residents. Staff also presented a draft on the staffing needs of the Aquatic Recreational Center.

8. Update on Urban Forestry Grant.

One hundred trees from the DNR approved species list will be planted in Robinson Park and along the Expressway. Project to begin this spring and completed by fall.

9. Bills.

A motion was made by Commissioner Martin, seconded by Commissioner Broeren, to approve the bills. Motion carried.

10. Staff Reports.

Mary provided a verbal report. Matt provided a verbal and written report.

11. Adjourn.
