Aquatic Center

Located at 681 Chestnut Street, Fun for every age!

Ben Hansen Park 🐾

2121 2nd Avenue South

Fits approximately 40 people in open shelter (first-come, first-served). Play equipment, kayak launch, volleyball courts, outside water faucet, power in shelter. Adjacent to WI State Firefighter's Memorial; restrooms located in Firefighter's Memorial building.

Gaynor Park

Baker & 5th Street N
Walking area.

Henry Demitz Park 🐾

1050 3rd Street South

Accessible fishing pier, fitness stations, bike repair and kayak/canoe launch area.

Legion Park 🐾

931 1st Street North

Paved walking path; picnic area.

Lyon Park 🐾

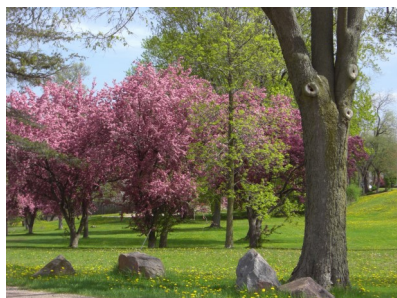
2nd Avenue South & Expressway

Open shelter, restrooms, play equipment, outdoor grill, bike trail.

Mead Athletic Field

17th Avenue & Chase Street

Play equipment, tennis courts, pickleball courts, ball diamonds, restrooms (open during league games only).



Mead Rapids View Park 🐾

Riverbank north of Jackson Street Bridge

Passive recreation area, site of the Clock Bell Tower, paved walking area.

Mead Splash Pad

Near corner of Alton Street and 14th Avenue

Open Memorial Day through Labor Day. Splash pad restrooms open during splash pad hours.



Municipal Zoo

1921 Gaynor Avenue

Zoo (free admission), petting zoo, Helen's House (rentable enclosed shelter), open shelter (first-come, first-served), outdoor grill, restrooms, play equipment.

Poplar Springs Park 🐾

Springs & Poplar Street

Baseball backstop, play area, sledding hill.

Robinson Park

1150 17th Street North

Rentable open shelter with picnic tables, band shell, ball diamonds, play equipment, park pong, disc golf, horseshoe pits, volleyball court, and restrooms.

Sand Lot Park

Sampson & Goodnow Street, 9.8 acres

Rentable open shelter with enclosed kitchen, picnic tables, play equipment, ball diamonds, volleyball courts, horseshoe pits, and basketball court.

Savaughn Park

Boles Circle

Wooded park area.

Skate Park

Corner of 8th Street South/Chestnut Street

Open to skateboarding, aggressive skating, BMX biking. Lighted facility. Helmet and safety gear strongly recommended. 7 a.m.-11 p.m. daily (April until snow)

Veterans' Memorial Park 🐾

2nd St between Grand Avenue & Jackson Street Bridge

Paved walking path, drinking fountain, American flag disposal box.

Ward Johnson Park (North Park) 🐾

3100 North Avenue

Baseball backstop, tennis court, basketball hoop, play equipment, small sledding hill.

Witter Field

8th Street South & Apple Street, Chestnut & Lincoln

Home of the Rafters summer league baseball team, lighted tennis/pickleball courts, ice skating, warming house, and skate park.



Woods Grove Park

16th Street North & Franklin Street

Passive recreation area baseball backstop.

East River Bank Conservancy Area 🐾

2nd Street South, between East Grand Avenue and Mead Street

Fishing, passive recreation and kayak launch.

West River Bank Conservancy Area 🐾

1st Avenue South, between West Grand Avenue & 2nd Avenue South

Fishing, walking path, dock and kayak launch.

Available Park Rentals

Helen's House, at Wisconsin Rapids Municipal Zoo, 1921 Gaynor Avenue, (\$150+key deposit), enclosed shelter; air conditioning, kitchen, restrooms; accommodates 50-60

Robinson Park, 1150 17th Street North (\$100+key deposit if using band shell), open shelter/fireplace, accommodates up to 200

Sand Lot Park, 453 Goodnow Avenue (\$100+key deposit), open shelter; enclosed kitchen, accommodates 75

Aquatics Center (681 Chestnut Street)

Rapids Room (Indoor Shelter)

Resident: \$150/day+key deposit

Non-Resident: \$250/day+key deposit

Refrigerator, microwave, sink, serving window, counter space, eight 8' tables, accommodates 75 (Pool passes not included)

Open Shelter (outside of fence)

\$100/day, Eight 8' tables, electrical outlets accommodates 60-70 people

Large Family Area Shelter (covered area at mechanical building) \$80/day, Six 6' tables, accommodates 35-40 people

Cleaning/key deposit of \$100 CASH is required when you pick up shelter keys. Please see parks.wirapids.org for more details, or scan below for our park shelter rental application.
