



1. Call the meeting to order.

2. Roll call.

3. Approve March 13, 2024 meeting minutes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner Albrecht, to approve the March 13, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

4. Approve March 20, 2024 meeting minutes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner Albrecht, to approve the March 20, 2024 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

5. Discuss the monthly report and activities of the Police Department with the Deputy Police Chief.

A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner King, to approve the monthly report and activities of the Police Department. Motion carried.

6. Discuss the monthly report and activities of the Fire Department with the Fire Chief.

A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner King, to approve the monthly report and activities of the Fire Department. Motion carried.

7. The Commission will vote to go into closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, which reads: "Considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility." In closed session, the Commission will:

- a. Discuss the placement of one (1) Firefighter on permanent status.
- b. Hear introductory comments by Fire Chief Eckes regarding the Entry-Level Firefighter candidates.
- c. Interview four (4) Entry-Level Firefighter candidates.
- d. Establish Entry-Level Firefighter eligibility list.



A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner King, to go into CLOSED SESSION pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Sec. 19.85 (1)(c), to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the Commission has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. Roll call vote taken. All members voted in the affirmative. Motion carried.

Present in the closed session were Commissioners Albrecht, Grode, King and Yonkovich; and Fire Chief Todd Eckes and Ryan Hartman.

In closed session, the Commission discussed the placement of one (1) Firefighter on permanent status and interviewed four (4) Entry-Level Firefighter candidates.

8. The Commission will return to OPEN SESSION and may take any necessary action or make any recommendations needed as a result of the discussion in closed session.

A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner King, to go into open session. Motion carried.

Re Item 7d: A motion was made by Commissioner Grode, seconded by Commissioner King, to place four (4) candidates on the eligibility list for Entry-Level Firefighters. Motion carried.
