Refuse and Recycling

- Garbage Collection estimate 450.64 tons, 408.01 tons in 2023
- Recycling Collection estimate 96.7 tons, 87.82 tons in 2023

Construction

Apricot/ Broadway Street Intersection

Items to complete

- Sidewalk, Curb and Gutter on Apricot Finish Grade and Pave Apricot

Lincoln Street (Peach Street – East Riverview Expressway)

- Removed asphalt, curb and gutter, sidewalk and black dirt from 1200' of roadway
- Installed 775' of 8" sanitary main, 12 Services and 4 manholes, one manhole 20' deep and another was 15' deep
- Installed over 800' of 12" ductile water main 3 fire hydrants and valves and 3 side road piping, valves and connections
- Sub graded existing sand and hauled in road base for the intersection of Lincoln and Chestnut, and Lincoln Street to Witter Street from Chestnut.

Streets Maintenance

- Mastic crack repair East Riverview Expressway from 8th Street South – Expressway Bridge
- Remove excess dirt, installed fresh black dirt, seed and mulch areas that were disturbed in sidewalk repair areas
- Removed trees in construction area that were needed to complete the projects or would have been damaged
- Poured Curb and gutter, sidewalk and approach slab in alley maintenance areas. Restored black dirt seeded and mulched
- Saw cutting asphalt patches in curb repair areas
- Saw cut asphalt patches in sanitary repair areas
- Catch basin maintenance in curb and gutter maintenance areas
- Completed first brush pickup for the year. Curb side brush collection is always the last full week of the month. Curbside collection is done from April.
- Assisted Parks with Tree Care
- Remove weeds from concrete or asphalt boulevards
- Screened compost at Westside Compost site
- Assisted with Brush grinding at Westside Compost site
- Screened and added material to Waste Water Class A sludge
- Cold Patch City Streets

- Swept streets and islands and paved boulevards. Entire city has been swept at least once. Typically sweep residential streets once every four to five weeks.
- Started repairing grass that was damaged plowing snow
- Worked on a small snow events
- Took delivery of 600 tons of salt

Paint and Signs

- Continue replacement of the Stop, Yield and regulatory signs that no longer meet the requirements of the MUTCD
- Removed existing signs in Lincoln Street Construction areas
- Built signs for Lincoln Street Project
- Replaced damaged mailboxes
- Painted stop bars and 8" channel lines for Grand Rapids
- Replaced signs that were damaged due to accidents

Shop and Repairs

- Routine service work fleet trucks
- Service Police and Fire's fleet
- Removed sanders, plows and wings from snow fighting vehicles
- Removed loader wing supports from machine
- Removed wing from main grader
- Prepared two Multi Axle Trucks and Street Sweeper for auction
- Replaced head gasket on compost turner
- Ambulance and Fire Truck repairs
- Switch out tires on
- Replaced hydraulic cylinders on the recycling truck
- Replaced hydraulic lines on tractor backhoe
- Warranty work on Volvo EC 145 Excavator
