What is SafeAssured ID?

SafeAssured ID provides peace of mind for families while protecting their privacy, the high-tech SafeAssured Mini-CD offers a single storehouse of information containing the following details:

- Up to ten digital fingerprints
- Digital photograph
- Streaming video showing mannerisms and gait
- Voice track providing the youth's voice inflection and accent
- General physical description
- Vital personal information (street address, date of birth, life-threatening medical conditions, identifying scars, marks and tattoos)
- Family code word
- Ability to create missing person posters from the Mini-CD
- All in a professional jewel kit given to the parent

Where do I store my SafeAssured ID?

We recommend storing the kit somewhere that is easily accessible 24 hours a day. For example, we recommend taping it in a kitchen cupboard, or in a family desk drawer. Keeping the ID in a safety deposit box at a bank may not allow you to retrieve the information on a moments notice in the case of a missing child, because Minutes Matter.

How Often do I Update a SafeAssured ID Kit?

Each parent should use their own discretion in deciding when to update their child's SafeAssured ID kit. As your child's features change, the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children recommends a current kit be produced.

Where else is my child's information stored?

There is NO database Stored. Enrollment forms are shredded and the computerized enrollment data is deleted. There is no computer with the information of enrolled children. The only information is contained on the SafeAssured ID Mini-CD.
