

Drinking Fountains Given by Joseph Cohen Are Here

Two monumental drinking fountains, given to the city by the late Joseph A. Cohen last fall, have arrived in the city and will be put in place as soon as suitable locations have been selected and weather conditions permit, it was said today by C. P. Gross, manager of the electric light and water commission.

The fountains consist of concrete blocks about four feet square and four feet high, made to resemble Bedford stone and each carries an ornamental light post. It is said to have been Mr. Cohen's wish that one fountain be erected on each side of the river, and it is probable that this will be arranged, although no locations have been definitely selected.
