1. Call to Order

2. Line truck replacement

The Utility's current trouble truck is 10 years old and for the past several years this truck has had several major mechanical issues and repairs. A replacement for the vehicle has been included and approved in the 2021 electric department capital budget. Based upon the bids received and the recommendation of staff, there was a motion made by John Bergin, seconded by Scott Kellogg, and carried to accept the bid from Utility Sales and Service for the purchase of a 2021 Versalift/Ford F550 in the amount of \$146,934. No nay votes were recorded.

3. Revision of the employee's Policies and Procedures Manual

After review and discussion there was a motion made by John Bergin, seconded by John Harper, and carried to approve the revision to Section 301 - Call-In Provisions and Section 302 – Overtime Compensation policies. No nay votes were recorded.

4. Baseball field project

After discussion, there was a motion made by Scott Kellogg, seconded by John Harper, and carried to supply labor and material for the electric and water service for the baseball field project in the not-to-exceed amount of \$55,000. No nay votes were recorded.
